Directions from the chair are to be followed and the chair reserves the right to ask anyone to leave who refuses to accept any reasonable direction, uses inappropriate language or behaves in any other way which could cause the meeting to become unmanageable.

If no one has arrived at the meeting within 10 minutes of its commencement unless someone has advised that they wish to attend and will be late, the meeting will come to an end.
